

CORWITH TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

FEBRUARY 4, 2026

FIRE/RESCUE: Kassuba contacted the contractor on door at the Fire Department that goes up too fast.

PLANNING COMMISSION/PARKS & REC: Kellogg reported that meeting dates were set for 2026. Planning Commission officers to remain the same.

ROADS: Kassuba has not heard back from Kirk Harrier at the Road Commission on the email sent on local road maintenance schedule.
